



## About ALERT

ALERT is a not-for-profit organization working to ensure 'Right to Life' a reality in India by bettering the emergency response eco system, for over a decade. ALERT's core initiative is Golden Hour Care & Emergency Response management. Working towards the Goal: "Train one in every family in Emergency Response", set by former legendary President Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, we have, to date, trained over 56000 people across varied walks of life. On one hand, we empower the common man by training him/her in Emergency response, and on the other work with various stakeholders of the emergency care eco system such as the legal, judicial, enforcement, EMS, hospitals, Government, research etc., to bring about synergies and advocate policy making in this space. ALERT's curriculum is jointly developed by the Indian Medical Association (IMA) & endorsed by the Governments of Tamilnadu and Karnataka and is approved to be offered as a credit course at IIT, Madras.



ALERT Simulation Lab for Emergency Response Management is India's first for a common man to develop life-saving skills using high end simulation equipment. ALERT's work has been awarded 'Hero of the Year' by Association of Healthcare Providers of India (AHPI), 'Good Samaritan' - Organisations category by Columbia Asia and 'Top 120 Social Enterprises to watch for in Asia' by DBS- NUS.

## A Typical Workshop – Awareness Programs

This training program aims to generate awareness and provide training in handling an emergency situation. A typical session would last for about four hours with some dedicated time for hands on experience. The topics that get addressed in the training session are as follows –

- Inhibitions to render assistance during an emergency
- Chain of Survival
- Basic Life Support Principles & ABC of basic life support
- Common Medical Emergencies Bleeding (external & internal), Fainting, Fractures, Seizures, Choking, Burns, venomous stings and bites etc.
- CPR Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation
- A brief about the 108-ambulance service with its benefits
- A live demonstration of the 108 ambulance (wherever possible)

## <u>PEER Workshop – Skilled Programs</u>

Personal Empowerment in Emergency Response is a programme designed and envisioned by ALERT Simulation Lab for Emergency Response Management, keeping in mind the requirements of a lay person to learn emergency response. The programmes incorporate latest recommendations from the American Heart Association and weaves them into real life scenarios in an Indian context, thereby giving the learner universal protocols in handling emergencies even while relating to an Indian setting. The classifications of PEER programmes are as follows:

**PEER – Basic**: Imparts fundamental concepts of emergency response with adequate practice of skill.


**PEER – Advance**: Uses advanced laerdal link technology to assist in effective mastering of skills required and incorporates AED Readiness.



## 2017 - Major Challenges


### Implementation of VoICE:

A life is invaluable in every sense and every time we hear from the citizens who have been trained by us in Emergency Response, it furthers our passion for compassion. Here are a few incidents where ALERT trained citizens have impacted victims of medical emergencies positively.

Mr. Nandakumar, an IT professional and an ALERT trained volunteer has mustered courage and intervened in 2 emergencies during the month of October alone! Both the emergencies were road accidents that occurred near the Adyar bridge at night. In the first incident, he shares that the crowd around the victim has over-powered him and did not allow him to put the victim in

the recovery position reminding us that we have a long way in instilling awareness among the general public.

In the second incident, he explains that he was able to successfully take control and implement the BLS procedures learnt by him during the training. The victim was a male and he was semi-conscious due to the fall from 2 wheeler, while Nandakumar found him on the road beside his weeping wife and kid. The victim had a head injury, was shocked but conscious and responding. Nandakumar quickly learnt that the people gathered around had called ambulance. His situational



leadership kicked in and he decided to take the victim's wife and kid a little away from the scene to calm down the situation. He then put the victim in recovery position. Thanks to Nandakumar, the family got quick help and another good Samaritan helped them get to nearby hospital. This time Nandakumar left the situation better & returned home with contented heart.
