







This Financial year sparked like a dream, especially how it had bounced back to normalcy post-pandemic. We scaled up in numbers, training over 55324 people in 23 districts of Tamil Nadu and 16 states of India. For this to come to fruition, we had a lot of support from many communities like Rotary. 


The ALERT Model

ALERT adopts a 3 layered approach in building capacity in our society. The 3 layers will give the intrinsic benefit of building a watertight medical emergency response ecosystem.

Awake - Aim of this layer is to sensitize the society. It helps them in preparing their mind to act at the time of emergency be it to their own family members or for others. They form the immediate outer layer of support to early responders and skilled first responders. They act as a support responders.

Aware - Awakened individuals need to be exposed to fundamentals of emergency care for preparedness/response so that they form the second layer of support to skilled first responders. They act as a early responders.

Act - This is the layer of people who become the foot soldiers during emergency who are comprehensively trained in emergency care through continuous engagement. They act as skilled first responders.





MANAGING TRUSTEE

The year bygone has been another significant year propelling the mission towards saving lives. With collaboration as the mantra in an area of work that is multi-disciplinary, we are grateful to our partners whether it be our CSR partners, nodal offices of the Government, educational institutions, nodal offices of other authorities, our office bearers, our trainers, our volunteers etc., as we march ahead towards empowering common people in emergency response.

It is alarming to learn that loss of life due to sudden cardiac arrests have drastically increased in our villages. I am particularly delighted about the possibility of empowering the unreached and underreached in the rural areas of India through the IVRS based ALERT awareness cell phone radio. The pilot study has shown good results and with the learnings from it, we envisage using it as an effective medium to disseminate awareness modules in Tamil in Tamilnadu and other regional languages for other states in India.

In an effort to bring in the youth into the mission, the ALERT Golden Army has expanded its wings to 15 institutions this year, with thousands of students joining the respective college chapters to participate in the mission. The very first demonstration of the youth power came to the fore as ALERT set a world record along with the Coimbatore District Administration in Basic Life Support. Coming out of the shadows of the pandemic, this year our outreach was wide and deep as we set foot in 16 Indian states and over 24 districts of Tamilnadu across 13 different departments of the Government. We look forward to the oncoming year to go even deeper in our outreach towards the under-served in empowering them to save lives.

It is when we hear from our Volunteers in Case of Emergency (VolCEs) of real-life incidents of savings lives in emergencies, our energy to keep going with the mission gets re-instated every year. In all humility, I would like to share that one of the highest acknowledgements of our work came from an Army Officer who said, "You people are doing inside the country what we do at the borders. Keep doing." We march ahead dreaming of generating an army of community first responders to save more lives.







The device installation was inaugurated by N Kamini, Additional Commissioner, and N Kumar, Deputy Commissioner, Tambaram City Police. The initiative is supported by Ford Motor Company as a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) project titled 'Go Further in saving lives'.



In this regard, meticulous efforts have been taken up by the Colmbatore District Administration and Alert NGO in mobilising 5386 interested first responders from 49 institutions for Basic Life Support Training on September 10th 2022 which has been cited in the Asia Book of Records.

Similar efforts are required from all District Administration to take up the Innuvir Kaappom - Udhavi Sei Thittam and make it into a Peoples movement for Road Safety.

As per ref 2nd cited, under Tamil Nadu Accident and Emergency Care Initiative (TAEI), World Trauma Day has been observed every year on October 17th 2022 by Involving First Responders like Police, Fire, Revenue, Local administration, EB- Electrical, PWD, Public Welfare groups, Medical, Nursing and paramedical staff and students and organising IEC to general public, on Prevention and Management of RTA/drowning/industrial accidents, Mock drills, Maes casualty drills etc.(Oath to be taken and IEC materials are enclosed as

This year as part of World Trauma Day, District Administration is requested to organise Basic Life Support Training from Oct 17th 2022 to 21th October 2022 in the hot spots /black spots already identified by field survey teams at the policy station level that was formed based on the instruction of Special Task Force for Road Safety comprising of Head Constable, Road Inspectors, 108 EMT/Pilot and the Engineering college staff and students.


ALERT CELLPHONE RADIO

"I was on my way in cab to office in the morning of February I, when I came across an accident. In the remote roadway of Chik Thirupati, Malur road, Karnataka, two boys, both not older than 25 years, had met with a bike accident from driving rashly. I stopped my cab, and went to inspect the victim's condition. Many onlookers gathered, but no one had called the ambulance. When I noticed that few people were about to give water to the victims, I immediately stopped them. Only one victim was breathing, but he was semi-conscious and couldn't give back proper response. Though, I didn't have a first-aid kit, I made the scene safe. My office employees phoned the ambulance and they came to know that it would arrive in an hour.

Even after I asked many times, nobody was ready to give a piece of cloth to arrest bleeding. Finally, my cab driver brought a new cloth for me, and I rendered first-aid. It wasn't sufficient and after sometime one of the victim's phone rang. I immediately attended the call and asked the person to come there. At the same time, I was arranging a vehicle that could carry the victim to hospital. Without proper support, the victim got into the car. The friend arrived at the scene in a few minutes and I sent him off in the car to hospital. Though it was challenging for me, I am happy that I was able to give first-aid assistance, that I learned at ALFRT, to the save accident victims."

"Today, I'd like to share my anecdotal experience as a trainee of the ALERT VolCE program and not as a Chapter Coordinator. Two months ago, as I was leaving to college, I stumbled across a circle of bystanders crowding around on a main road. When I went to check what was happening, I came to know that a 11th grade school student had fainted. People lay him down in an uncomfortable position and had not even removed the school bag from off his shoulder. Despite being a Doctorate professor, if I had not attended the VolCE training and learned about First-Aid, I knew I would have either ignored the accident or, at most, given water to him from my bottle. But I stepped forward to check for the boy's vitals. I felt relieved when he responded back to my Response Check. After confirming that the ambulance was dialed, I carefully put him in Recovery Position. We waited and when the ambulance arrived, the paramedics took care of him. Later, I came to know that the boy was safe and was out of trouble. I felt really satisfied that I applied the simple steps of BLS and happily reminisced over this feeling of 'gifting a life to someone' the whole day. I could take timely action only because of the VolCE training provided to me by ALERT NGO. I pray that no accident must befall on anybody, but if they do occur in future, I am confident that I will fearlessly provide appropriate First Response help on the victim."
